Inspect Your HVAC System: Before you turn on your heater for the winter, make sure the entire system is in good working order. Consider purchasing a maintenance contract with a reputable HVAC service company. They start around \$200 per year and often pay for themselves with two free annual seasonal checkups of your system and significant discounts on labor and/or parts if you need repair during the contract period.

Change Furnace Filter: There are different levels of filter available — - those that capture a lot of particles, those that capture only a few, and those in-between. Filter labels generally state specifically what they filter out and what they don't.

Professional Chimney Inspection/Cleaning: Have a licensed contractor professionally clean and inspect your fireplace/chimney once a year to remove crosote build-up and detect and repair firebox or chimney liner cracks, gas line leaks, chimney cap or bird screen cracks and other fire hazards.

Clean out gutters: As winter approaches, falling leaves may clog gutters and lead to water backup that could damage your exterior siding. Now is the time to call a professional to have all of your gutters and downspouts cleaned of leaves and debris.

Check your tire pressure: As temps drop, so does the air pressure in your tires.

Clean out dryer vent

Test smoke alarms- replace batteries

Check caulking and weather stripping- inside and out
