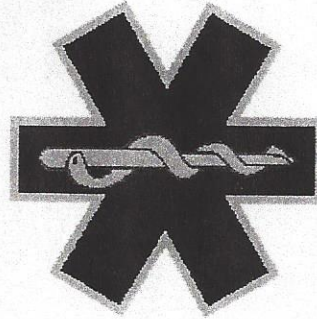

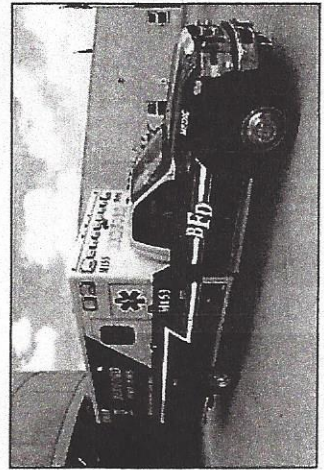

# The Ambulance Subscription Program

A voluntary program offered only to the residents of Bedford as an opportunity to offset the high costs of Emergency Ambulance Transport.



- Bedford residents may purchase an annual subscription to cover emergency ambulance service fees which are not paid or reimbursed by medical insurance coverage.
- Annual subscription memberships shall provide benefits for the member, his/her spouse, unmarried children under twenty-five (25) years of age and other qualified dependents, as determined by the Internal Revenue Service, and who live at the same address as the member.
- Membership covers out of pocket expenses for emergency ambulance services only within the City of Bedford. No coverage for non-emergency transfer ambulance services shall be provided.
- Membership enrollment periods will be based on the calendar year and must be renewed annually.
- Coverage begins immediately upon enrollment.
- Medicaid Recipients are not eligible
- Residents may sign up at anytime for this great opportunity

*Bedford is offering a very beneficial ambulance subscription program to save citizens out of pocket cost for their Emergency Ambulance Service.*



The current membership fee is **\$60** per household.
